Lab coat

White long sleeved laboratory coat, and it should be three centimeter below the keen.

Clean and pressed uniforms and lab coats to be worn at all times.

Hijab and Niqab

All female students must cover their heads (Hijab) all time but the Niqab is optional.

Should be black or white (non-attractive color)

Niqab is should be without decorations, freshly laundered on a daily basis.

A surgical mask must replace Niqab whenever sterile procedures are being performed.

Shoes

Shoes must be clean and in good repair.

Enclosed toes and cover heal.

Low heel with rubber soles that makes no sound while walking in the clinical areas.

Make up

Full Makeup is prohibited in clinical settings.

Uniform

Lab coats are to be closed and worn over scrub suits, or over long sleeved shirt with business trousers
Denim Jeans or form fitting clothes are not allowed to wear .

Badge

KSAU-HS Badge pinned to left lower pocket of the uniforms.

Nails

Nails must be Clean and short at all times.

Jewelry

The students are not allowed to wear the jewelry while on duty except for the wristwatches
